

BIG SHOT FOR IVECO BUS

Iveco Bus signed a framework agreement with DB FuhrparkService GmbH for the supply of 400 Crossway buses in addition to another optional 310

Very big order for Iveco Bus. German company DB Regio Bus commissioned 400 buses on the basis of a framework agreement signed by Iveco Bus, a brand of the CNH Industrial Group, with DB FuhrparkService GmbH, a subsidiary of Deutsche Bahn. The vehicles belong to the Crossway and Crossway LE (Low Entry) range. Deliveries are scheduled for the two-year period 2015-2016. The agreement also includes the option to supply 310 additional vehicles for delivery in 2017 and 2018.

The Crossway is built according to EBSF (European Bus System of the Future) and VDV (Association of German Transport Companies) standard requirements. The Euro VI Crossway version comes fitted

as standard with new and wider windows and VDV driver's workspace, therefore with increased comfort, accessibility and safety.

The Crossway range is equipped with engines with HI-SCR system without the use of EGR for the after-treatment of exhaust gases, thus reducing weight for the advantage of compactness and easy maintenance.

DB Regio Bus, whose fleet already includes Iveco Bus vehicles for quite a while, manages regional bus routes and

suburban transport operations on behalf of Deutsche Bahn. It has a network of 22 bus companies with a stake in more than 70 private and municipal public transport entities in Germany. It transports about two million bus passengers a day. ●
